Cardio Club (7th-8th Grade): Start your weekend right with an active cardio circuit before school on Friday mornings! Running club will meet Friday mornings at 7:15 in the Big Gym with Mr. Berglund and Miss Cronin.

Girls on The Run (5th Grade Girls)- This program is for girls in grades 3-5. It is designed to allow every girl to recognize her inner strength and beauty. The program combines physical fitness (running) with a curriculum that promotes social and emotional development and growth. Girls learn how to have positive attitudes, establish healthy friendships and learn strategies to deal with everyday challenges that girls face at this age. Girls also learn about choosing to live healthy and happy lifestyles. The team meets on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons from 3:20-4:30. The program lasts eight weeks and ends with a celebratory 5K race on May 19th!
